### **Policy**

Normally promotion to Full Professorship requires excellence, at levels defined by the unit, in teaching, research, and service. However, it is permissible for a unit to adopt criteria supporting promotion to Full Professorship primarily on the basis of a sustained record of truly outstanding teaching, with the expectation for research being less demanding than in the normal case. Units wishing to adopt such teaching-oriented criteria must define a special review procedure utilizing an examination and documentation of the candidate's teaching performance exceeding the normal level of scrutiny. The teaching performance itself must be shown to be outstanding, not merely "good" or "excellent."

### **Knowledge**

This option is not available with regard to criteria for tenure and promotion to Associate Professor.
