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Policy

All candidates for faculty positions who are interviewed on-campus must be interviewed by the Dean or one of the Associate Deans. The interviewer should be provided with (a) the candidate's <u>curriculum vitae</u>, (b) letters of recommendation, and (c) the substantive information regarding the candidate's prior teaching performance already obtained by the recruiting unit.

Knowledge

All such candidates for teaching positions at the assistant professor level must be provided with an opportunity for a substantive instructional interaction with undergraduate students, so that the recruiting unit can assess the candidate's potential to be an effective teacher of University of Arizona undergraduate students. Such instructional opportunities are recommended for candidates for senior positions, but are not required in cases where the prior record regarding the candidate's teaching performance is clear and positive.
