Policy

Because space is becoming more and more scarce, especially on campus, in many cases research supported by grants should be housed in off-campus space. In reviewing grant proposals, the Dean's Office personnel will check for provision of space, and inclusion as necessary of direct costs for space leasing in the grant budget.

Knowledge

However, there are cases in which it is in the University's overall best interests to lease space for conduct of grant-funded activities, and obtain full on-campus indirect cost returns, rather than the off-campus rate. In determining the best way to handle the need for new space, it may be advisable to discuss this issue with the Office of the Vice President for Research.
