### Policy

The following are the prestigious fellowships and awards recognized in considering requests for an externally-funded research assignment.

The Faculty Advisory Council will review proposed new additions to this list, and advise the Dean on their appropriateness. Faculty applying for a fellowship not included on this list who wish to take advantage of the externally-funded research assignment policy must propose the anticipated fellowship to the Faculty Advisory Council at the time of their application, not at the time they receive notice of the award. Proposals should conform to the intent of the policy, which is primarily to increase the number of truly prestigious awards obtained by SBS faculty.
